

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
AN AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, it would be appropriate to establish an airport advisory committee to review and make recommendations relating to airport development, operation, and revenues;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That there is established the Juneau Airport Advisory Committee which consists of nine persons appointed by the assembly for staggered three year terms; except, of those first appointed, three shall be for one year terms, three shall be for two year terms, and three shall be for three year terms. The committee shall, to the extent possible, consist of persons representing the following interests:


- (a) Two persons representing large airlines.
- (b) Two persons representing small airlines or charter operators.
- (c) One person representing flight schools.
- (d) One person representing private aircraft owners.
- (e) One person representing airport lessees who are not represented in (a) through (d).
- (f) Two members of the public who do not have any of the interests represented in (a) through (e).

The airport manager shall be an ad hoc member of the committee. There shall be one assembly member appointed as a liaison member to the committee.

2. That the committee shall meet regularly to review airport development, operations, and revenue needs and

projections. The manager shall provide staff assistance to the extent there are funds available for such purpose. The committee shall report its recommendations to the assembly.
