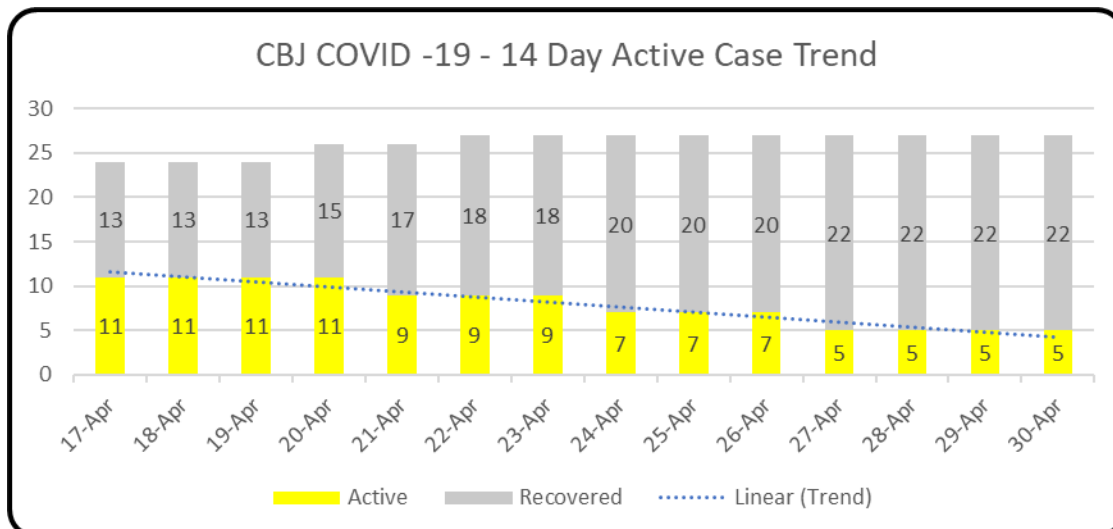

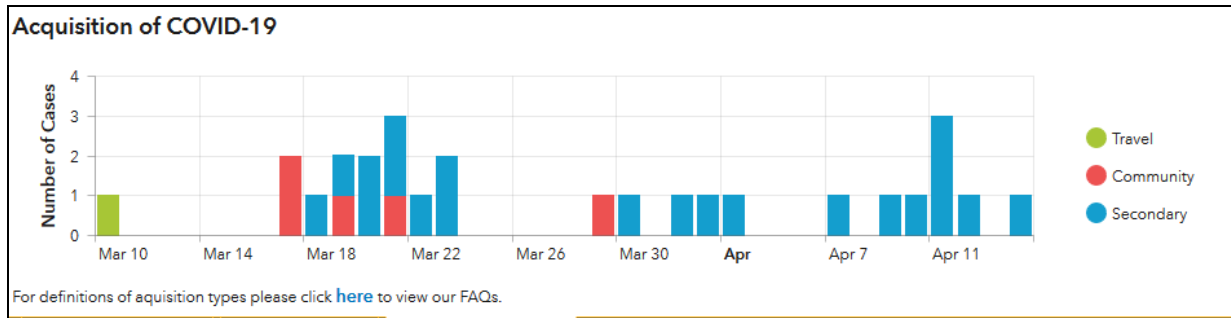

EOC Highlights

Operational Period 11 began (4/30/2020 – 5/07/2020). BRH informed us today they are moving to a 2 week operational period.

The EOC continues to work on obtaining community wide test kit availability.

Working with DPH on congregate setting testing.

DPH is working with LCCC and local social service providers to assure that there is a good plan in place as inmates are released into the community.

Operational Highlights

Airport Screening: Screened 5 passengers out of a total of 47 arriving. AK Air moving from 6 to 8 flights in May.

Mobile Screening: 20 calls came into the hotline, 8 referred for testing. There were 3 tests at drive through, 1 at home. To date, sampled 318 for testing. 1 welfare checks was completed via phone. There will be an operational shift change beginning on May 1st to allow for additional testing of patients for non-emergent medical treatment as required by Health Mandate 15.
