Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 15 (6/11/2020 – 6/25/2020).

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

There was one new case in Juneau today and no new nonresident cases associated with Juneau. The new case is considered secondary transmission. There are still 3 cases under investigation. Contact tracing capability remains unconstrained.

Testing:

We are experiencing delays in testing turnaround from both the state lab and commercial labs. We continue to explore ways to reduce the turnaround time for both.

Hospital Response:

BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.


Issues of Note:

We are exploring options on increasing capacity for local rapid testing.

The Division of Public Health reported that we have had 3 total positive tests from our Airport Screening operations: 6/5 - 6/11: 2 positive, 6/12 - 6/18: 1 positive
