Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 15 (6/11/2020 – 6/25/2020).

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

There are no new resident or nonresident cases in Juneau today or over the weekend. All nonresident cases are considered recovered and there are two active cases amongst residents. Contact tracing capability remains unconstrained.

Testing:

Staff and supplies are unconstrained. Turnaround time is still slower than we would like but seems to be slowly improving.

Hospital Response:

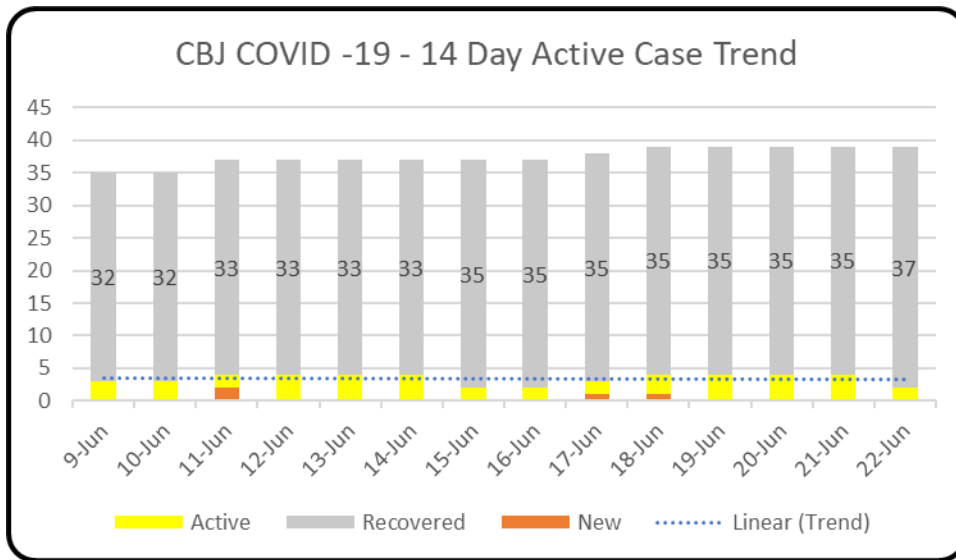
BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.

Issues of Note:

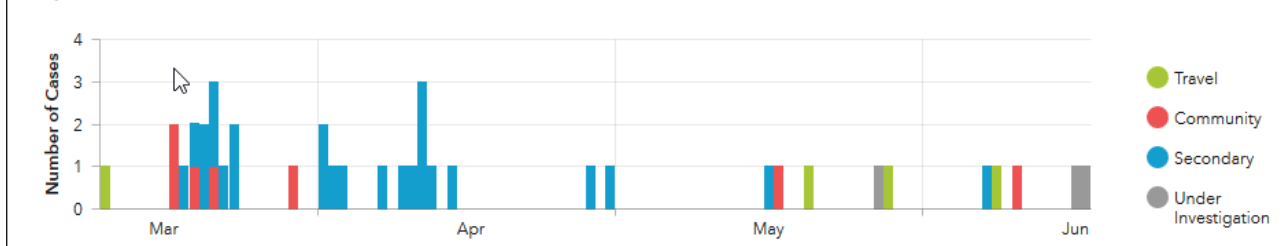
AMHS begins mainline ferry service beginning June 26th. It appears they are requiring passengers to present in Bellingham with a negative COVID test, or to test at the terminal and quarantine aboard the ship similar to what happens when someone flies in via a Commercial Airport. Masks are required aboard all AMHS vessels for passengers and crew. A testing voucher is being provided at the Canadian border when people come in to Haines or Skagway.
