Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 16 (6/25/2020 – 7/9/2020).

<u>Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:</u>

There was one new resident case reported in Juneau today. There was additionally one new non-resident case reported today that is tied to the mining industry. Preliminarily, we understand that the individual associated with this case did not expose others (including other miners) and was detected as intended under the mitigation plan implemented by the employer.

Both of these new cases are under investigation.

Contact tracing capability remains unconstrained.

Testing:

Staff and supplies are unconstrained.


Hospital Response:


