## Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 16 (6/25/2020 – 7/9/2020).

## Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

There was one new resident case reported in Juneau today which is under investigation. Hecla Mining confirms that the non-resident case from yesterday tested positive during mandatory pre-shift quarantine.

Contact tracing capability remains unconstrained.

<u>Testing:</u> Staff and supplies are unconstrained.

Hospital Response:


BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.

We do not yet know if the ventilated BRH patient is COVID+ or not.


Numbers changed from yesterday are highlighted. DPH does not update persons under investigation (PUIs) over the weekend.
