 RE: City & Borough of Juneau COVID-19 Response – Emergency Operations Center Update

Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 16 (6/25/2020 – 7/9/2020).

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

There are no new resident cases reported in Juneau today and 28 new cases statewide. There are additionally 2 new statewide non-resident cases, 1 of which is in Juneau.

DHSS reports they are at or near their upper limit on contact tracing capacity statewide, including locally. DHSS, in partnership with UAA, is hiring additional contact tracers. More information on contact tracing here: <https://www.uaa.alaska.edu/academics/college-of-health/departments/ACRHHW/>

Testing:

Staff and collection supplies are unconstrained. Recent test turnaround times have been between 2 and 7 days. We saw our largest reported number of daily tests to date today (363).

Hospital Response:

BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.

Issues of Note:

As testing requirements change throughout the country, there is increasing public confusion about testing options. We will be putting out new information about testing protocols and where individuals can be tested. In general, free testing is currently provided to individuals experiencing symptoms or those covered under State mandates (e.g. out of state travelers or long-haul AMHS passengers).

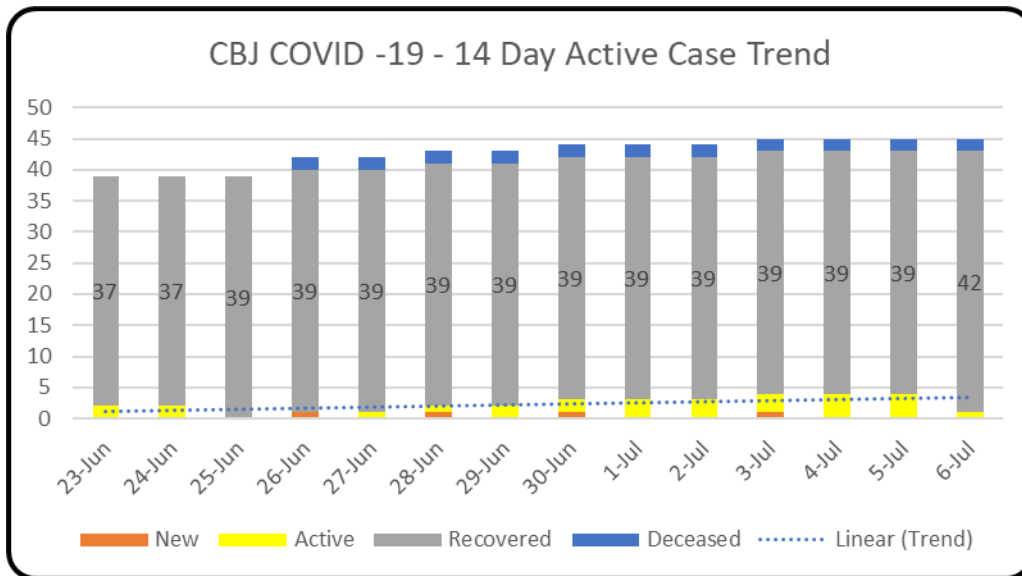
The Juneau School District health team currently staffs the COVID-19 hotline and they will be returning to their usual duties in early August. We are working on a transition plan to maintain the hotline.

We have started discussions to extend Emergency Shelter services through April of 2021.

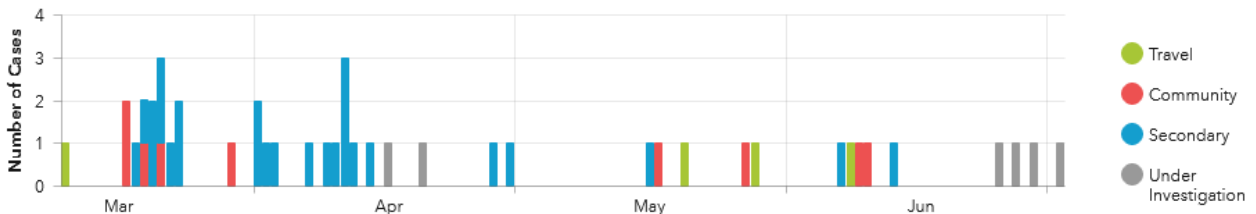
