Situation Assessment: We are experiencing a high volume of new cases, a significant number of which are attributed to community spread. Our 14 day and 7 day case rate indicators are at the high alert level. The community is urged to take appropriate cautions and in particular to refrain from indoor, unmasked activities with individuals outside of family/social bubbles

Issues of Note:

The popup testing center at Centennial Hall is fully operational. 283 people were tested on Friday. I don't have numbers from the Saturday operations but reports were traffic was steady throughout the day. Testing will continue on Sunday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.

The State Lab notified us this morning that they had to unexpectedly close today. They will be open tomorrow.

Daily Numbers Report:

Public Health does not report cases over the weekend, however we had 7 new cases reported yesterday after 5:00pm. Those cases are reflected in the updated numbers below. Public Health is attributing two of the cases to the emerging situation with the social event/bar exposures, one to secondary transmission, and the remaining cases are under investigation.

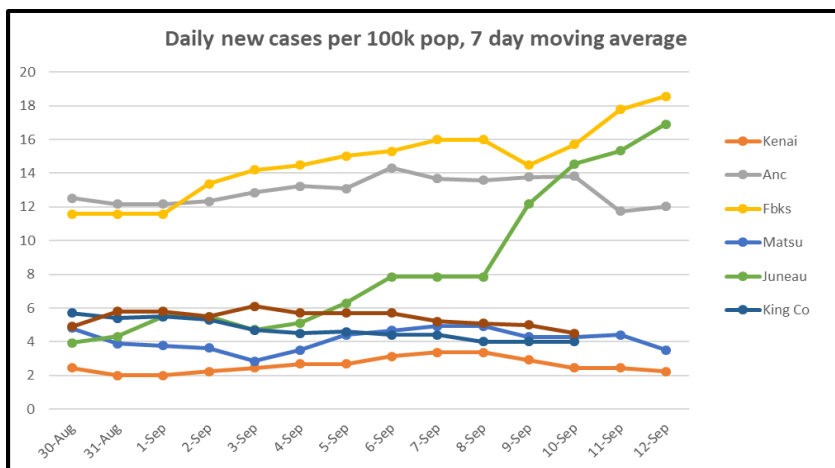
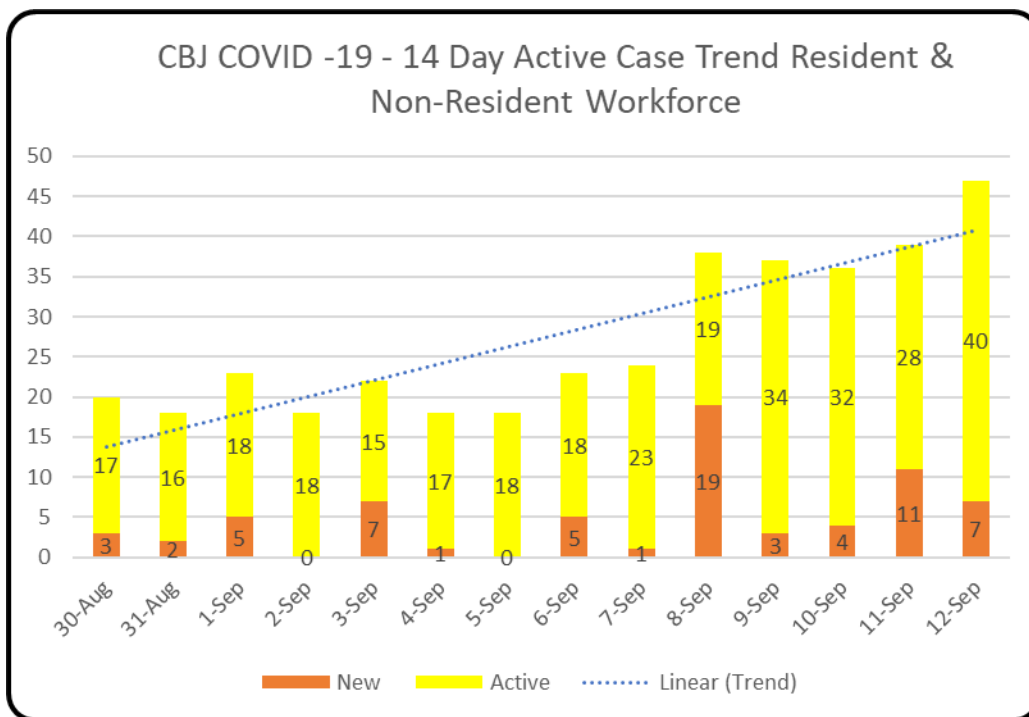
Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

There are 7 new resident and no nonresident cases reported for Juneau today. CBJ continues to show a higher number of resident and nonresident cases than what is reported on the state dashboard. In addition, our recovered numbers continue to be larger than what is being reported by the state. Both discrepancies are due to more timely local reporting.

The State of Alaska is reporting 103 new cases today bringing the statewide cumulative case count to 7,131.

Testing:

We did not receive updated testing numbers today.



This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (<https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/>) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting.
