**Situation Assessment:** Our 14 day case rate is at the High alert level and our 7 day case rates has dropped to the Moderate alert level. The disease is moving across all disease acquisition types: secondary infection, travel and community. Travel related cases remain elevated. Residents must take appropriate cautions, including limiting social bubbles to immediate family members. The public should strictly adhere to all health orders related to travel.

## **Issues of Note:**

Asymptomatic testing is under way at the Fire Training Center. Total tested so far is 473. 308 of those tests have been processed, with 3 tests returning positive. Testing will be available through Jan. 10<sup>th</sup>.

The State has published that Phase 1 b, Tier 1 will include people who are 65+. As a reminder, we are currently in Phase 1a, Tier 3. More information on registration for this age group will not be available until late January. However, there appears to be misinformation about how or when people in that age group can register. This will be a focus of communications strategy next week.




## <u>Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:</u>

We are reporting no new resident cases and no new nonresident cases. The state dashboard updated but numbers were not available for Juneau.

The State is reporting 239 new cases today for a cumulative total of 48,098 cases.

Testing: Test turnaround times will be reported on Monday, January 4th.
