**Situation Assessment:** Our 14 day case rate is at the moderate alert level and our 7 day case rate has dropped to the minimal alert level. The community continues to see COVID spread in the community with a higher proportion of cases occurring in youth under the age of 19. Two variants of concern have been identified in Juneau - (UK/B1.1.7 and Brazil/P1). Case rates statewide are declining.

**Issues of Note:**

Clinics are scheduled for every Thursday from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm through the end of July at the Juneau Public Health offices. The clinics will use Pfizer and Janssen as it is available. Additional June clinics are in the process of being scheduled.

**May 22**, 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. at the old Household Hazardous Waste Building, 5436 Commercial Blvd.

**May 26**, 12 – 4:30 p.m. at True North Federal Credit Union, 2777 Postal Way.

The EOC is working on arranging surveillance testing for unvaccinated individuals who work closely with youth and those who work in high contact public facing businesses (bars, restaurants, small retail.) We expect testing programs to begin the week of June 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Daily Numbers Report:** We are reporting 3 new cases today (Monday 1:00 pm – Wednesday 1:00 pm).



Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

We are reporting 2 new resident cases and 1 new nonresident case. All 3 cases are under investigation. The private party cluster has 9 positive cases with 6 people recovered.

That State is reporting 97 new cases today bringing the statewide total to 69,729 cases. This is a total of 129 new cases since the last EOC report.


Testing: 85 COVID tests were processed at BRH since the last EOC report, all tests returned in less than 24 hours.




Total: **60.9%** of the of the total population of Juneau has received at least 1 dose of vaccine and **56.9%** have completed their vaccine series.

12+: **71.0%** of the age eligible Juneau population has received at least 1 dose of vaccine. **66.3%** have completed their vaccine series.

65+: **94.7%** of this age group has at least one dose of vaccine. **91.6%** have completed the vaccine series.





This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (<https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/>) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting.
