Situation Assessment: 14 and 7 day case rates are at the moderate alert level. The community continues to see COVID spread in the community with a higher proportion of cases occurring in youth under the age of 19. Three variants of concern have been identified in Juneau - (Alpha/B.1.1.7, Beta/B.1.351, and Gamma/P1). Case rates statewide are declining.

Issues of Note:

In light of declining cases, the State of Alaska is now only updating their dashboards for case rates and test positivity Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Hospital data and Vaccine data is still available Monday – Friday. As a result, the CBJ Risk Metrics Dashboard will be updated Monday, Wednesday and Friday. The CBJ Covid-19 dashboard will continue to update on a daily basis Monday – Friday.

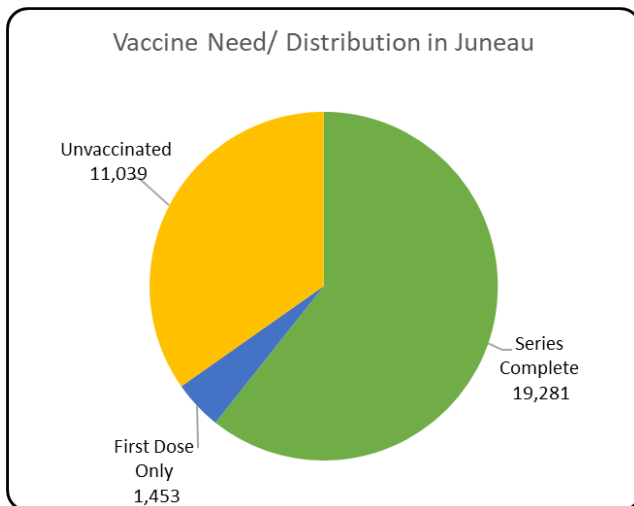
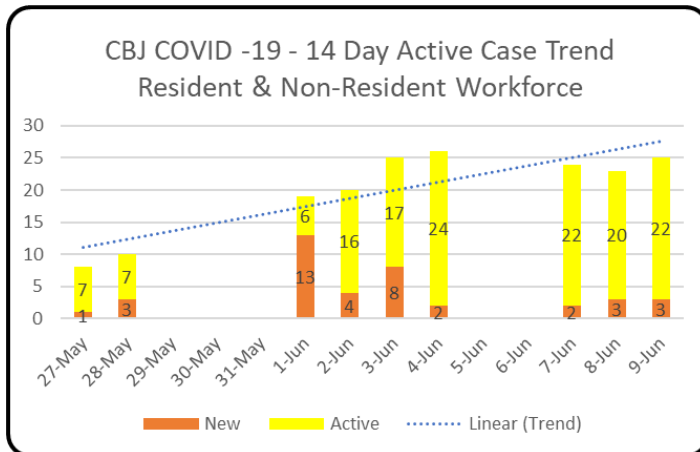

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

We are reporting 6 new resident cases and no new nonresident cases. The 4 of the cases are secondary infection and 2 remain under investigation. The daycare cluster so far has resulted in 9 positive cases, with 2 cases recovered.

That State is reporting 26 new cases today bringing the statewide total to 70,588 cases. This is 68 additional cases since the last EOC report.

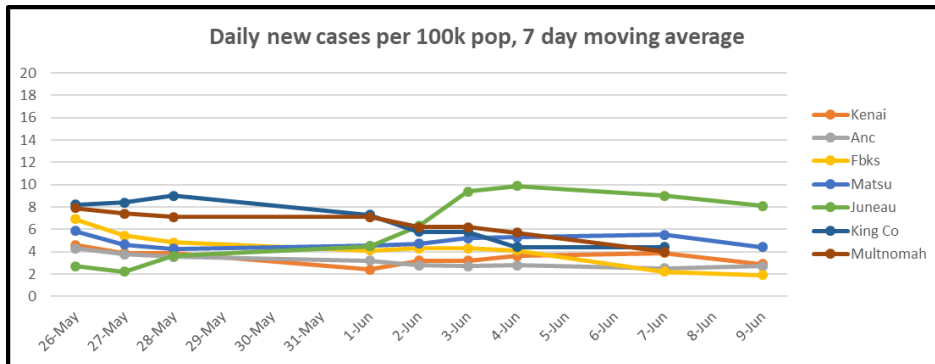
BRH has proceed 104 tests at the local lab since the last EOC report. All tests returned in under 24 hours.



Total: **65.3%** of the of the total population of Juneau has received at least 1 dose of vaccine and **60.7%** have completed their vaccine series.

12+: **76.1%** of the age eligible Juneau population has received at least 1 dose of vaccine. **70.7%** have completed their vaccine series.

65+: **90%** of this age group has at least one dose of vaccine. **87%** have completed the vaccine series. (State updated dashboard)



This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (<https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/>) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting.
