**Situation Assessment:** The 14 day and the 7 day case rate are at the low alert level. The community continues to see COVID spread in the community with a higher proportion of cases occurring in youth under the age of 19. Three variants of concern have been identified in Juneau - (Alpha/B.1.1.7, Beta/B.1.351, and Gamma/P1). Case rates statewide are declining.

**Issues of Note:**

We administered 98 doses at two clinics on June 16 (True North Federal Credit Union) and 17 (Juneau Public Health). There is a clinic at the downtown theatre this evening timed for the after work, early evening crowd in the downtown bar and restaurant areas. It runs from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

Airport testing has been in place for a year. Since inception, the testing has identified 126 COVID positives.

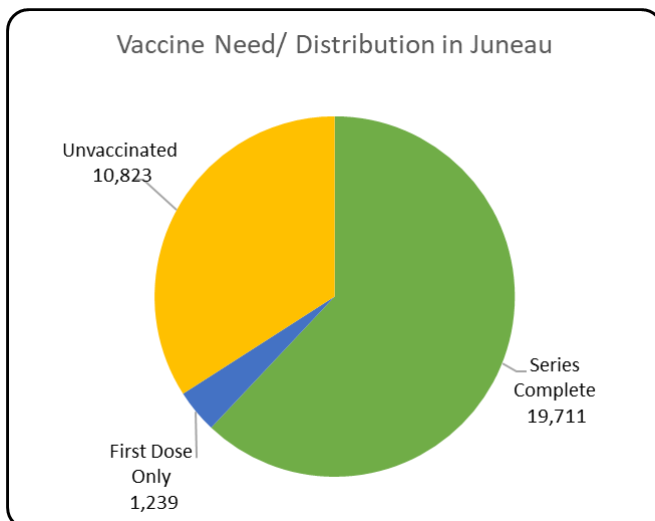
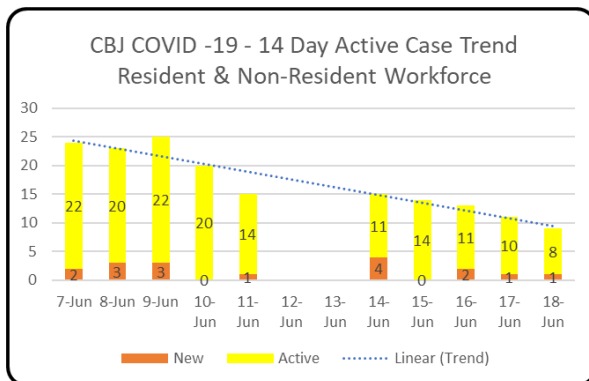

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

We are reporting 2 new resident cases and no new nonresident cases. 1 case is secondary infection and the other case remains under investigation. The daycare cluster so far has resulted in 13 positive cases, with 12 cases recovered.

That State is reporting 105 new cases within the past 2 days bringing the statewide total to 70,875 cases.

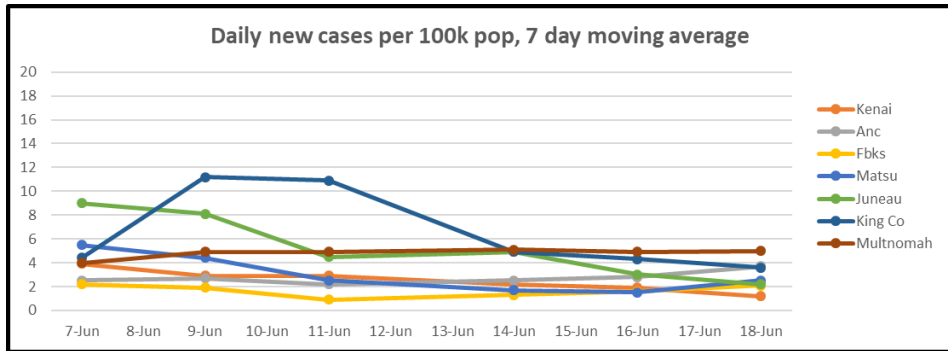
73 COVID tests were processed through BRH since the last EOC report, all with less than 24 hour turnaround



Total: **65.9%** of the of the total population of Juneau has received at least 1 dose of vaccine and **62.0%** have completed their vaccine series.

12+: **76.8%** of the age eligible Juneau population has received at least 1 dose of vaccine. **72.3%** have completed their vaccine series.

65+: **90%** of this age group has at least one dose of vaccine. **88%** have completed the vaccine series. (State updated dashboard)



This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (<https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/>) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting. Policy recommendations at varying levels (<1, <10, <25, 25+) can be found on their website
