**Situation Assessment:** The 14 and 7 day case rates are at the low alert level. The community continues to see COVID spread in the community with a higher proportion of cases occurring in youth under the age of 19. Three variants of concern have been identified in Juneau - (Alpha/B.1.1.7, Beta/B.1.351, and Gamma/P1). Case rates statewide are declining.



We are reporting 1 new resident case and no new nonresident cases. The reported case is secondary infection.

That State is reporting 49 new cases within the past 3 days bringing the statewide total to 71,086 cases.


84 COVID tests were processed through BRH since the last EOC report, all with less than 24 hour turnaround




Total: **66.5%** of the of the total population of Juneau has received at least 1 dose of vaccine and **62.7%** have completed their vaccine series.

12+: **77.5**% of the age eligible Juneau population has received at least 1 dose of vaccine. **73.1**% have completed their vaccine series.

65+: **90%** of this age group has at least one dose of vaccine. **88%** have completed the vaccine series. (State updated dashboard)
