Situation Assessment: The 14 and 7 day case rates are at the low alert level. Four variants of concern have been identified in Juneau - (Alpha/B.1.1.7, Beta/B.1.351, Gamma/P1, and Delta/B.1.617.2/AY.1). Variants appear to be contained but the public is reminded to follow appropriate precautions when traveling. Case rates in the Anchorage area are climbing.

Issues of Note:

The State is sending out 2nd dose reminders to people who have not followed through with receiving their second dose. In Juneau, we think that is a relatively small number but public health is requesting localized data to confirm.



Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

We are reporting 1 new resident case and no new nonresident cases. The reported case is under investigation.

That State is reporting 88 new cases within the past 3 days bringing the statewide total to 71,275 cases.


81 COVID tests were processed through BRH since the last EOC report, all with less than 24 hour turnaround




Total: **66.8%** of the of the total population of Juneau has received at least 1 dose of vaccine and **63.0%** have completed their vaccine series.

12+: **77.8**% of the age eligible Juneau population has received at least 1 dose of vaccine. **73.5**% have completed their vaccine series.

65+: **90%** of this age group has at least one dose of vaccine. **88%** have completed the vaccine series. (State updated dashboard)
