**ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA**

**Serial No. 2021-39**

**An Ordinance Removing or Extending the Sunset Date Relating to Licenses to Use Certain Rights-of-Way for the Selling of Food and Beverages.**

WHEREAS, in the spring of 2017, Ordinance 2017-02 was enacted, which created licensing standards for use of certain rights-of-ways for selling food and beverages; and

WHEREAS, section 5 of Ordinance 2017-02 imposed an automatic repeal clause (sunset date) of December 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2018-46 extended the sunset date three years to December 31, 2021.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

**Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City and Borough of Juneau Municipal Code.

**Section 2. Amendment of Section.** The sunset date provision originally enacted with Ordinance 2017-02 and codified with CBJC 20.25.080 and with CBJC 53.09.350 is repealed.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its adoption.
