

Liveaboard Information Downtown Harbors

REGISTRATION: Those interested in living aboard in Aurora, Harris Harbor, or Douglas Harbors must apply at the Aurora Harbor Office. <u>Both the Vessel Owner and Renter will need to fill out paperwork, and provide a lease agreement with a 6 month minimum.</u> **Failure to register will result in loss of moorage privileges.**

IDENTIFICATION: All registered liveaboards must provide a copy of a valid state or federal issued I.D.

FEE SCHEDULE: \$78.24 per month for up to 4 people. There is a charge of \$26.08 for each additional person.

ELECTRIC: Power boxes are available in all harbors. Transient vessel owners can purchase power from the harbor. Vessel owners with assigned stalls will need to set up an account with AEL&P. Harbor staff can assist you with this process.

WATER: Potable water spigots are located about every 75 feet. Water is available year round, however during winter months spigots are subject to freezing. Permanent water hook up is **NOT** allowed. **Citations may be issued for non-compliance**.

PETS: Pets are required to be in control and on a leash at all times. Dog bags are available at the top of all gangways for cleaning up after your pet. As a courtesy to other Harbor Patrons we require you to use them. **Citations may be issued for non-compliance.**

PARKING: Vehicle parking permits are available at no charge upon receipt of a current DMV registration. The parking lot includes both 3 day and 14 day spaces. **BE AWARE OF POSTED PARKING SIGNS.** Citations may be issued for non-compliance.

SANITATION: Dumpsters are provided at each Harbor.

All liveaboards must have a U.S. Coast Guard approved Marine Sanitation Device (MSD). In accordance with 05 CBJ 45.015, all MSDs are inspected by harbor staff. Any vessel found to be not in compliance will have 90 days from the date of inspection to correct the issue or be removed from the harbor.

Port-a-potties are located at each Harbor approach.

There is a Token-op hot shower located in Harris Harbor at the top of the ramp. Inquire at the Aurora Harbor office for information about accessing the showers.
