RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2693

A Resolution Repealing Resolution 1828 and Reestablishing the Fees for Appeals.

WHEREAS, CBJ 01.50.030(b)(7) provides that the Assembly may establish appellate fees by resolution; and

WHEREAS, there has been no increase to the City and Borough's appellate filing fee in the last 18 years; and

WHEREAS, this increase is consistent with the filing fee imposed in other municipalities, both in Alaska and nationally; and

WHEREAS, this increase more closely represents the true costs incurred by the City and Borough in managing appeals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. That the schedule of fees and charges for appeals shall be as set forth below:

(a) A filing fee of \$500 shall be charged for an appeal to the Assembly of a decision of a board or commission. This fee shall be paid whether or not a filing fee was charged by the board or commission appealed from.


(b) Any party requesting a transcription shall pay the costs thereof.

Section 2. The fees established by this resolution may be wholly or partially waived by the Manager upon a showing by the party seeking the waiver that the party is unable to pay. The standard for determining inability to pay shall be substantially the same as that used to determine eligibility for representation by the municipal public defender.


Section 3. Repeal of Resolution. Resolution 1828 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
