This year we will see the arrival of the USS WILLIAM LAWRENCE, an Arleigh Burke-class guided-missile destroyer which will arrive early afternoon to be part of the Maritime Festival. As part

Aurora Phase III Update: The work to complete "H float" is moving along well; however, the substantial completion date has been moved two weeks to June 1st. This is the result of several factors including contractor delays due to the heavy snowfall in January, a Docks & Harbors decision allowing the contractor to perform salvage work from the winter storms in the Juneau harbors and supply chain delay for electrical components. We will update patrons as soon as we have the electrical system operational and ready for occupancy.

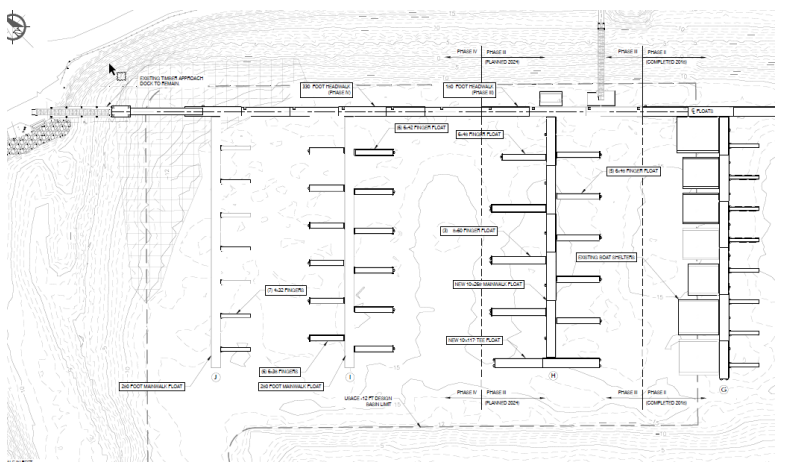

Aurora Phase IV Update: The State Legislature has placed sufficient funds into the ADOT Harbor Facility Grant program for FY25. Assuming there is no veto from the Governor's Office, we will have \$10M to move forward with the fourth and final phase of Aurora Harbor later this fall. This is the proposal Phase IV layout which has been discussed with the Docks & Harbors Board as well as at the Infrastructure Fair.



Launch Ramp Permits: As the weather improves, and boaters head out to launch their boats, please know that Docks & Harbors enforces the calendar year permit requirement for trailer registration. One can access on-line purchase of a recreational daily, or annual, as well as commercial daily or annual launch ramp permits [here](#) or at our Aurora or Statter Harbor offices.

Docks & Harbors Infrastructure Fair: On April 3rd, Docks & Harbors held its first infrastructure event to make the community aware of pending projects and grant opportunities which we are pursuing. Nearly 40 were in attendance for the presentation and meeting with Docks & Harbors staff to discuss and refine proposed improvements to our facilities.



New CBJ-wide Parking System: Docks and Harbors is excited to announce the modernization and standardization of our paid parking system in partnership with CBJ. All paid parking within CBJ (with the exception of Juneau Airport) will be managed through a unified system. Customers can now conveniently pay via phone using the IPS Park Smarter App. Additionally, payment and citation contests can be handled directly through the app. Self-service kiosks will still be available for those who prefer them, with existing kiosks being replaced by new units from IPS. Enforcement of paid parking will now rely on license plate numbers, eliminating the need for physical receipts on the dashboard. The new system is scheduled to launch concurrently with the start of paid parking for the season at Statter Harbor and the Taku Lot downtown on May 1st.
