### CANVASS OF SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

**Held June 12, 2007, Juneau, Alaska**

In accordance with CBJ 29.07.290, the undersigned Election Official of the City and Borough of Juneau canvassed the results of the Special Municipal Election held in Juneau, Alaska on June 12, 2007. The following are the official results of that election:

#### Proposition 1:

For the purpose of constructing a portion of Thunder Mountain High School and completing the construction and equipping of an auditorium, shall the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska, issue and sell its general obligation bonds, maturing within 15-years of their date of issue, in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$11,180,000?

#### Proposition 2:

For the purpose of the design and construction of an artificial turf field and running track at Thunder Mountain High School, shall the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska, issue and sell its general obligation bonds, maturing within 10-years of their date of issue, in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$5,000,000?

#### Proposition 3:

For the purpose of paying for a portion of the cost to equip Thunder Mountain High School, shall the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska, issue and sell its general obligation bonds, maturing within 15-years of their date of issue, in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$920,000?

Election Statistics:

Total registered voters in the City and Borough of Juneau was 24,494. 5231 ballots, including absentee and accepted questioned ballots, were cast in the election. Voter turnout was 21.36%. Ballots were cast in the following manner:
