ORDER

Motion to File Overlength Brief<sup>1</sup>

Defendants move for leave to file an overlength brief. Plaintiffs have responded thereto. For good cause shown, defendants' motion for leave to file overlength brief is granted.

1. Defendants shall serve and file defendants' combined cross-motion for summary judgment and opposition to plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment, along with any statement(s) of fact relating to defendants' combined brief (including any objections and responses to plaintiffs' statement of facts) in excess of the combined 100-page limitation, no later than one (1) day after entry of this order.

2. Without further leave of court, plaintiffs may serve and file a combined opposition to defendants' cross-motion for summary judgment and reply in support of plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment, along with any statement(s) of fact necessary to support plaintiffs' combined brief (including any objections and responses to defendants' statement of facts) in excess of the combined 75-page limitation, up to and including 150 pages.

3. The deadline for CLIA to file CLIA's opposition and reply to CBJ's combined cross-motion and opposition, CLIA's opposition to CBJ's motion to strike, CLIA's reply in support of its motion to take judicial notice in connection with CLIA's motion for summary judgment, and any response or opposition by CLIA to any other related filings by CBJ are extended to the date that is three weeks from the date on which CBJ files its combined cross-motion and opposition. The deadline for CBJ to reply in support of CBJ's cross-motion for summary judgment and CBJ's motion to strike are extended to two weeks from the date on which CLIA files its opposition and reply to CBJ's combined cross-motion and opposition and related filings. No other dates set forth in the court's order (briefing schedule)<sup>2</sup> are extended.
