The Court, finding that the request is appropriate under the circumstances and agreed upon by the parties, hereby ORDERS as follows:

Plaintiffs shall file the following papers, to the extent they deem it necessary, on or before March 23, 2018:

- 1) Reply in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 67) and Opposition to Defendants' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 118);
- 2) Response to Defendants' various Statements of Facts (ECF Nos. 118-1, 118-2, and 118-3);
- 3) Reply in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion to Take Judicial Notice (ECF No. 79);
- 4) Opposition to Defendants' Motion to Take Judicial Notice (ECF No. 135);
- 5) Opposition to Defendants' Motion to Strike Certain Exhibits (ECF No. 99);
- 6) Opposition or other necessary response to Defendant's Sealed Motion Requesting Leave to File Documents and Pleadings Under Seal (ECF No. 105);
- 7) Opposition or other necessary response to Defendant's Motion Requesting Leave to File Exhibit HY Conventionally (ECF No. 138); and
- 8) Any additional motions or papers necessary to address Defendants' supporting documents, including the various affidavits filed by Defendants (ECF Nos. 131, 132, 133, and 136).

Defendants shall then file the following papers, to the extent they deem it necessary, on or before April 17, 2018:

1) Reply in Support of Defendants' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 118);

- 2) Reply in Support of Defendants' Motion to Take Judicial Notice (ECF No. 135);
- 3) Reply in Support of Defendants' Motion to Strike Certain Exhibits (ECF No. 99);
- 4) Reply or other necessary response to Defendant's Sealed Motion Requesting Leave to File Documents and Pleadings Under Seal (ECF No. 105); and
- 5) If necessary, oppositions or responses with respect to any papers filed by Plaintiffs pursuant to paragraph (8) above.

Finally, to the extent that Defendants file any oppositions or responses to the papers filed pursuant to paragraph (8) above, Plaintiffs shall file their supporting replies on or before May 1, 2018.

Additionally, Defendants' Reply in Support of their Motion to Determine the Law of the Case (ECF No. 81) and Defendants' Opposition, if any, to Plaintiffs' Motion to Take Judicial Notice in Connection with Plaintiffs' Opposition to Defendants' Motion to Determine the Law of the Case (ECF No. 98) shall be filed on or before March 13, 2018. Plaintiffs' Reply in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion to Take Judicial Notice in Connection with Plaintiffs' Opposition to Defendants' Motion to Determine the Law of the Case (ECF No. 98) shall be filed on or before March 27, 2018.
