At Docket No. 98, plaintiffs move the court to take judicial notice of two exhibits attached to their opposition to defendants' Motion to Determine the Law of the Case. This motion for judicial notice is unopposed.

Exhibit 1 is a CBJ notice regarding proposals for the Marine Passenger Fee proceeds for 2018 and Exhibit 2 is a list of all actions taken on Senate Bill 1214, the Maritime Transportation Security Act of 2002. Both of these exhibits are available on government websites. "Under Rule 201, the court can take judicial notice of [p]ublic records and government documents available from reliable sources on the Internet, such as websites run by governmental agencies." Gerritsen v. Warner Bros. Entertainment Inc., 112 F. Supp. 3d 1011, 1033 (C.D. Cal. 2015) (citation omitted).

Plaintiffs' motion at Docket No. 98 is granted. The court will take judicial notice of the two exhibits offered by plaintiffs in support of their opposition to defendants' Motion to Determine the Law of the Case.
