## Port Director's Corner

Docks & Harbors (D&H) will be in front of the Planning Commission on Tuesday, November 13<sup>th</sup> for the purpose of securing all necessary permits to construct transportation staging and expanded waterfront deck-over along the Seawalk at the Archipelago Lot. The Community Development Department Staff has posted information on the Conditional Use Permits, City Project Review and Flood Zone Exception requested by D&H to: <a href="https://beta.juneau.org/assembly/assembly-minutes-and-agendas">https://beta.juneau.org/assembly/assembly-minutes-and-agendas</a> The public is encouraged to participate in the process and may testify at the November 13<sup>th</sup> meeting which starts at 7 pm.

Docks & Harbors held a public meeting on October 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Mendenhall Valley Library to solicit input to a proposed extension to the Amalga Harbor launch ramp. Five members of the public attended the meeting and were briefed on the plan to construct a new 75 foot float extension with up to 4 fish cleaning stations. The proposed concept will be similar to the fish cleaning float at False Island (Craig, AK) pictured below. Those in attendance were supportive of the project which will be funded with \$280K from ADFG Sport Fish Restoration grant (aka Dingell-Johnson Act). It is anticipated that D&H will have a contract to advertise in January to build and install the float by May 2019. Those in attendance also encouraged D&H to mark the adjacent rock outcrop with an aid-to-navigation.



**Live-Aboard Regulations.** As a reminder, 05 CBJAC 20.050 pertains to a "Residence surcharge" which is defined as "a fee assessed to the owner of a vessel when the vessel is used by any person as a residence, dwelling, or abode for <u>three or more calendar days</u> in any calendar month..."
