**Tracy Arm**

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82% of Alaska resident mountain goat hunters list their community of residence as Juneau.

100% of Alaska resident brown bear hunters list their community of residence as Juneau.

100% of Alaska resident black bear hunters list their community of residence as Juneau

0% of furbearers taken by Alaska residents list their community of residence as Juneau

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**Northern Admiralty Island**

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79% of Alaska resident brown bear hunters list their community of residence as Juneau

95% of Alaska resident Sitka black-tailed deer hunters list their community of residence as Juneau

47% of all furbearers sealed by Alaska residents list their community of residence as Juneau

It is important to note that the information above is only for those areas identified as possible annexation lands. Hunter effort and residency can, and does, change dramatically by simply moving drainages or across water bodies. The percentages should be considered estimates because it is difficult to identify exactly where the annex lands are and hunter reporting does not always provide exact locations.
