

Fire Station Tours & Visits

Visitors are welcome to meet firefighters, paramedics and emergency medical technicians and see the equipment used to keep our Juneau neighborhoods safe.

Our Down Town and Airport stations are open daily between the hours of 10:30 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM for tours and visits.

What is a Station Visit?

- A quick unscheduled stop to see the fire trucks and talk to the firefighters. (If the firefighters are available.)
- 2-6 people max.
- Last about 10-20 minutes

What is a Station Tour?

- An in depth look at what the firefighters wear, drive and why they have the best job in the world.
- Tours are limited to one class at a time. Max 30 people total.
- Last about 20-30 minutes.

Tour Criteria:

- Please allow a minimum of two weeks in advance to schedule a tour.
- We require one adult for every five children visiting our facilities.
- Fire stations remain "in-service" during tours. The firefighters may need to respond to emergencies at any time. If they do, it will be necessary for the tour to end and your group to exit the station.
- Please be aware that even with booked tours, the possibility exists that the crew could be called out and the station will be closed when you arrive.
