

**2020 Juneau Parks and Recreation Youth Basketball
Post Season Tournament Rules**

All Parks and Recreation league-specific rules apply to the tournament.

Remember that this is a recreational league. Please remind all players and spectators about **sportsmanship** and **having fun**. No trophies, t-shirts, or other awards are given to the winning team. Good luck and have a good tournament!

***Please note - one parent from each team is required to keep score during tournament games.**

1. **Playing Time** - Every player in attendance must play a minimum of ½ of the **regulation** game time. Please notify the official and opposing coach before the game begins if a player will not be playing his/her full time. Parks and Recreation staff may be at tournament games to observe playing time.
2. **Personal Fouls** - Each player is allowed FIVE personal fouls per game. Technical fouls count towards personal foul totals.
3. **Technical Fouls** - A player receiving 2 technical fouls or 1 flagrant technical is ejected from the game and will sit out the next game (minimum). A team accumulating four technical fouls forfeits the game.
4. **Time Outs** - Play continues when the team calling the time out returns to the court, regardless of how much of the one minute is used. No additional time outs are given in the three-minute stop clock period. One extra time out is given to each team in each extra period.
5. **Protests** - Protests are not accepted.
6. **Overtime** - The overtime period is three minutes, stop clock. It begins with a jump ball at center circle. If still tied after three minutes a sudden death period is played, stop clock, with no time limit. The sudden death period is also started with a jump ball. The first team to score wins; foul shots are taken.
7. **Dunking** - Any player caught dunking the ball or hanging on the rim receives a flagrant technical foul and is ejected from the game and will sit out the next game (minimum).
8. **Three-Point Shots** - Counted on any court with three-point lines.
9. **Double Forfeit** - The referee conducts a coin toss to determine the winner.
