RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1948

A Resolution Authorizing Imposition of a Surcharge Payable to the State of Alaska Upon a Plea to, Forfeiture of Bail for, or Conviction of Certain Infractions and Misdemeanors.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature by 1998 SLA, Chapter 56, requires municipalities to collect and remit to the state a surcharge payable upon a plea to, forfeiture of bail for, or conviction of certain infractions and misdemeanors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. The Manager shall provide for the imposition, collection, and remission to the State of Alaska of the surcharges specified in Section 2.

Section 2. A defendant who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, forfeits bail for, or is convicted of:

(a) violating CBJ 72.10.010 or CBJ 72.10.012 shall be assessed a surcharge of \$75,

(b) a misdemeanor or a violation of an ordinance if a sentence of incarceration may be imposed therefor, other than the provisions listed in subsection (a) of this section shall be assessed a surcharge of \$50,

(c) a misdemeanor, an infraction, or a violation of an ordinance if a sentence of incarceration may not be imposed therefor shall be assessed a surcharge of \$10 if the fine or bail forfeiture amount is \$30 or more.

Section 3. The Manager shall arrange with the Alaska Court System pursuant to AS 29.25.075 for collection and remission by the court of the surcharges specified in this resolution, shall pay any fee established by the Supreme Court for such service, and shall

apply for reimbursement from the state pursuant to AS 29.25.072(a) for such fee and any other costs of collecting the surcharge and transmitting it to the state.


Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
