RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1954

A Resolution Supporting Litter Free, Inc. and Authorizing the Manager to Donate \$6,500 in Recognition of the Continuing Efforts by Litter Free to Maintain a Clean and Healthy Environment in Juneau.

WHEREAS, the citizens of Juneau live in uniquely beautiful surroundings and wish to maintain a clean and healthy environment in which to live, work and play, and

WHEREAS, Litter Free, Inc. is a non-profit organization with a broad spectrum of volunteers from the community, and

WHEREAS, Litter Free, Inc. sponsors the annual spring cleanup, which garners community-wide support for the removal of litter from public and commercial common use areas, and

WHEREAS, Litter Free, Inc. organizes smaller cleanups using clubs and organizations to perform the labor throughout the year, and

WHEREAS, Litter Free, Inc. offers public education to all members of the community, with an emphasis on educating young school children to develop good litter free habits and awareness of recycling, and

WHEREAS, the city and borough has provided Litter Free, Inc. with a yearly donation to aid its efforts toward coordinating cleanups of public areas in the city and borough by volunteer groups and non-profit organizations, and

WHEREAS, the city and borough has budgeted funds in FY99 for cleaning up public lands, which includes the anticipated annual donation to Litter Free, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. That the Assembly supports the efforts of Litter Free, Inc.

Section 2. That the Assembly authorizes the manager to donate \$6,500 to Litter Free Inc. in recognition of its continuing contributions to a clean and healthy environment in the city and borough.


Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
