WHEREAS, CBJ 53.50.220(c) provides that upon a determination by the Manager that the best interests of the public would be served, the Manager may transfer any surplus City and Borough supplies to another governmental or quasi-governmental unit except that where the estimated value of the surplus of supplies to be transferred exceeds \$1,000, the transfer may be made only after approval by the Assembly by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

**Section 1.** That the Assembly approves the transfer of ownership at no cost of one 1985 GMC vacuum truck, Serial #1GDM7D1YDFV628317, to the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
