RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A Resolution Authorizing the Manager to Submit to the State of Alaska an Application for a Federal Grant to Plan, Develop, and Install Interpretive Signs to Identify Traditional Tlingit Places Throughout the City and Borough of Juneau.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the CBJ Comprehensive Plan to identify and protect historic and archaeological resources, and

WHEREAS, traditional Tlingit culture is an important aspect of Juneau's history, and

WHEREAS, it is an objective of the draft Historic Preservation Plan to educate and inform the general public about Juneau's unique history and Native heritage, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the National Park Service Historic Preservation Act of 1966, certain federal share matching grants for historic preservation projects are available to certified local governments, and

WHEREAS, the Juneau Historic Resources Advisory Committee has recommended application for a federal share matching grant to plan, develop, and install interpretive signs to identify traditional Tlingit places, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has reviewed the application prepared by the Community Development Department to plan, develop, and install interpretive signs to identify traditional Tlingit places, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly is fully aware of the obligations and responsibilities that will be incurred by the City and Borough upon acceptance of the grant;

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska:

- **Section 1.** That the Assembly hereby authorizes the Manager to submit an application to the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Office of History and Archaeology, for a federal share matching grant to plan, develop, and install interpretive signs to identify traditional Tlingit places.
- **Section 2.** That the Community Development Department is established as the agent for the City and Borough for administration of this project.
- **Section 3.** That if the City and Borough is awarded the grant to plan, develop, and install interpretive signs to identify traditional Tlingit places, the Assembly will introduce an ordinance providing matching funds for this project.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
