A Resolution Authorizing Payment of Compensation to Volunteer Firefighters for Service at Fires, Training, Drills, and Other Events as Approved by the Manager.

WHEREAS, volunteer firefighters expend substantial personal time and resources traveling to and serving at fires, training, drills, and other events, and

WHEREAS, these contributions are essential to the safety and well being of the citizens of Juneau, and

WHEREAS, it has long been an informal City and Borough policy to provide volunteer firefighters with a modest compensation to help defray the cost of transportation, equipment, clothing, and other expenses associated with emergency service to the community, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate at this time to formalize this practice with a policy statement by the Assembly;

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska:

Section 1. The Manager is authorized to pay each volunteer firefighter the sum of \$10 for each emergency callout, training session, or other event authorized in advance by the Manager. This amount shall be increased to \$14 for any firefighter certified as a Firefighter I.

Section 2. In addition to the amount specified in Section 1, each Volunteer Assistant District Chief shall receive \$900 per year, and each Volunteer District Chief shall receive \$1,200 per year.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
