A Resolution Naming the Public Waterfront Access at Tee Harbor in Honor of John and Louise Argetsinger.

WHEREAS, in August 2000, Mr. Michael J. Kirk donated and the City and Borough, pursuant to Resolution 1935, accepted Lot B-5, U.S.S. 2388, to be used as public waterfront access to Tee Harbor, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kirk has requested that the property be named in honor of John and Louise Argetsinger, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Argetsinger, as Chief Civil Engineer for Alaska Public Works, oversaw construction of many landmark buildings in Juneau, including the Municipal Building, Juneau-Douglas High School, Harborview Elementary School, and the original Juneau Library, which now serves as the City Museum, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Argetsinger, together with her husband, was active in the Methodist Church and instrumental in construction of the Methodist Camp now used by many Juneau organizations, and

WHEREAS the Argetsingers lobbied the Alaska Legislature for education and child welfare programs and were leaders in the Juneau Parent-Teacher Association, and

WHEREAS, The Parks and Recreation Committee at its meeting of May 1, 2001, recommended Assembly approval of the proposed name;

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska:

Section 1. The Tee Harbor public pedestrian waterfront access at Lot B-5, U.S.S. 2388 is hereby named the "Argetsinger Beach Access".
