RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A Resolution Establishing the Fiscal Year 2004-2006 CBJ Transportation Needs List and Nominating Projects for the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has received a request dated August 21, 2001 from the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (the "Department") to nominate projects for inclusion in the 2004-2006 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program, and

WHEREAS, the Department will consider City and Borough nominations for inclusion in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program for fiscal years 2004-2006, and

WHEREAS, the nomination process affords the City and Borough the opportunity to influence the process for deciding which projects are eligible for state and federal funding and become part of the State of Alaska's spending plan for improvements to Alaska's highway, ferry, and transit systems, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly Public Works and Facilities Committee at its meeting of September 27, 2001 developed and approved a list of project nominations based on the community's highest priority transportation needs;



Section 1. CBJ Project Nominations for the 2004-2006 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program. Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


