A Resolution Urging the Alaska Congressional Delegation to Support the Transfer of Forest Service Property Located at the University of Alaska Southeast to the University for Expansion of the Auke Bay Campus.

WHEREAS, the University of Alaska Southeast is an essential component of the State of Alaska higher education system, and

WHEREAS, the growth and expansion of the Auke Bay campus is critical to the success of the university, and

WHEREAS, the university is preparing a master plan to guide future development of university facilities, and

WHEREAS, the United States Forest Service owns 8.5 acres of land as an inholding in the campus property, and

WHEREAS, the highest and best use of this Forest Service property is for expansion of the university campus, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the Forest Service property to be transferred to the university;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


