RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A Resolution in Support of Statewide Bond Proposition C on the November 5, 2002, Statewide General Election Ballot, for the Purpose of Paying for the Cost of Design, Construction, and Major Maintenance of Educational and Museum Facilities.

WHEREAS, Bond Proposition C will appear on the General Election ballot for the election to be held on November 5, 2002, and

WHEREAS, Bond Proposition C, if approved by the voters, would fund important projects in the City and Borough of Juneau, including the Lena Point Fisheries Laboratory, and in addition many important projects throughout the State of Alaska, and

WHEREAS, Bond Proposition C if approved would cause HB2003 changes to be implemented which would provide the matching funding necessary to issue the voter approved bonding to construct a new high school, and

WHEREAS, accompanying this resolution is CBJ Ordinance Serial No. 2002-18 (AC), which would appropriate \$25,000 in support of Bond Proposition C, and


WHEREAS, the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska wishes to express its support for Bond Proposition C;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. The Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau places itself on record in support of passage of Bond Proposition C on the November 5, 2002 General Election ballot.


Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
