RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A Resolution Supporting Participation in the International City/County Management Association (ICMA) City/Links Program.

WHEREAS, the International City/County Management Association (ICMA), in cooperation with the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and other international agencies, established an international partnership program called the CityLinks Program; and

WHEREAS, through the CityLinks Program, selected local governments exhibiting a record of exceptional management in the United States have been invited to share their local government expertise and successes with communities in developing countries that are making the transition to democracy; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the CityLinks Program is to provide technical assistance in improving professional and ethical municipal management; and to increase economic development opportunities at the local level; and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska in cooperation with the Juneau Economic Development Council, has been chosen to participate in this extraordinary program to represent the United States by being matched with a community in Russia Far East.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. The Assembly supports the CBJ's participation in the ICMA CityLinks Program, and by so doing endorses the promotion of democratic principles in Russia Far East.


