**A Resolution Expressing the Assembly's Support for Including the Auke Bay Bike and Pedestrian Path Project in the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities Statewide Transportation Improvement Plan.**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT/PF) regularly considers projects for inclusion into the Statewide Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP); and

WHEREAS, the inclusion of local projects into the ADOT/PF STIP benefits the CBJ with the opportunity for local projects to be completed with State funding; and

WHEREAS, supporting the proposed Auke Bay Bike and Pedestrian Path project would benefit the community; and


