RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A Resolution Expressing Assembly Support for the Department of Parks and Recreation's Request for Technical Assistance from the National Park Service, Rivers, Trails, and Conservation Assistance Program.

WHEREAS, there are few areas in Juneau where off-highway vehicles (OHVs) may be used legally and the terrain and climate of Southeast Alaska present significant challenges to the design of an OHV park; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly supports the development of a sustainable, appropriately-located OHV park; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has appropriated \$125,000 in funding for the study, design, and development of a sustainable OHV park; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that technical assistance from the National Park Service's Rivers, Trails, and Conservation Assistance Program will contribute positively to the development of an OHV park, and will result in a more sustainable facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. That the Assembly hereby expresses support for the Department of Parks and Recreation's application for technical assistance from the National Park Service to develop a sustainable OHV park for Juneau.


Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
