RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2657

A Resolution De-Appropriating \$850,000 In Grant Funding For A Community Development Block Grant Awarded to Support AWARE In The Construction Of a New Emergency Safe Shelter Building.

WHEREAS, under Article IX of the Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Juneau, the Assembly by resolution may reduce any appropriation, except for debt service or for cash deficit, provided that no appropriation may be reduced by more than the amount of the unencumbered balance; and

WHEREAS, 2012-20(P) appropriated an \$850,000 grant from the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development as funding to support AWARE in the development of a new building adjacent to emergency safe shelter; and

WHEREAS, site preparation costs were higher than anticipated and would cause the cost of development to exceed the grant award; and


WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development has stated that this is a significant change and the funds cannot be reallocated to the revised project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


Section 1. The budget is de-appropriated from the Community Development Block Grant fund in the amount: \$850,000 from the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
