RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A Resolution Authorizing the Manager to Submit to the State of Alaska an Application for a Federal Grant to Develop Phase II of a Historic and Cultural Preservation Plan for the City and Borough of Juneau.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the CBJ Comprehensive Plan to identify and protect historic and archaeological resources, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau is currently in Phase I of the development of a historic and cultural preservation plan to guide the protection of historic and archaeological resources, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the National Park Service Historic Preservation Act of 1966, certain federal share matching grants for historic preservation projects are available to certified local governments, and

WHEREAS, the Juneau Historic Resources Advisory Committee has recommended application for a federal share matching grant to develop Phase II of a historic and cultural preservation plan, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has reviewed the application prepared by the community development department for a federal share matching grant to develop Phase II of a historic and cultural preservation plan, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly is fully aware of the obligations and responsibilities that will be incurred by the city and borough upon acceptance of the grant;

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska:

Section 1. That the Assembly hereby authorizes the Manager to submit an application to the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Office of History and Archaeology, for a federal share matching grant to develop Phase II of a historic and cultural preservation plan for the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska.

Section 2. That the community development department is established as the agent for the city and borough for administration of this project.

Section 3. That if the city and borough is awarded the grant to develop Phase II of a historic and cultural preservation plan, the Assembly will take up introduction of an ordinance providing matching funds for this project.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
