RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1886

A Resolution Adopting the Juneau Non-Motorized Transportation Plan.

WHEREAS, in 1979 the Assembly adopted Resolution 570 approving a bicycle plan for the development and operation of bicycle facilities in the city and borough, and

WHEREAS, in the eighteen years since adoption of the plan, the population of Juneau has increased by fifty percent, with seventy-seven percent of households owning one or more bicycles used in the last year, and

WHEREAS, in recognition of these changes the Parks and Recreation Department in 1992 began collecting data to support an update of the plan, and

WHEREAS, the analysis conducted by the department included many hours of staff work, and two public meetings in different areas of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, after consideration of all of the evidence and opinion available, the department prepared a draft plan for review by city and borough agencies, and

Whereas, the draft plan has been reviewed by the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee, the Planning Commission, and the Assembly Committee of the Whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. That the document identified as "Juneau Non-Motorized Transportation Draft Plan, August 1997" prepared by the Department of Parks and Recreation is approved and adopted as a general guide for the development and operation of non-motorized transportation facilities in the city and borough; provided that the plan may be changed by Assembly approval of facilities or programs different from or in addition to those in the plan.

Section 2. That the plan shall be known as the "Juneau Non-Motorized Transportation Plan."

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
