RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1895

A Resolution Authorizing the Manager to Accept the Conveyance of 8.2 Acres of Land at the Airport From the Federal Aviation Administration.

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration has offered to convey, at no cost, approximately 8.2 acres of land at the Juneau Airport, and

WHEREAS, the property is presently occupied by a portion of the airport terminal and parking lot, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the city and borough to own and control this property, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly Lands Committee, at its meeting of October 6, 1997, recommended acceptance of the property, and

WHEREAS, CBJ 53.04.030 provides that real property which is offered to the city and borough as a gift or at less than market value and which is not required for an approved project, may be accepted only upon the approval of the Assembly by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. Authorization. The manager is authorized to accept the conveyance of 8.2 acres of land from the Federal Aviation Administration.


Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
