RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES TO PERMIT THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU TO ASSUME THE DEPARTMENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES RELATING TO ACCESSIBILITY OF PUBLIC FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the legislature has appropriated to the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT/PF) funds for accessibility improvements for various public facilities as described in the attached Appendix A, and

WHEREAS, AS 35.15.080 provides that a municipality may, upon the concurrence of the commissioner of DOT/PF, assume DOT/PF's planning and construction responsibilities for public works projects of the state which are located within the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has the authority to receive and expend such funds and to contract for such work, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau desires to assume DOT/PF's responsibilities for the work;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That, pursuant to AS 35.15.080, the commissioner of the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is requested to execute one or more agreements with the City and Borough of Juneau which provide for the assumption by the city and borough of DOT/PF's responsibilities relating to the work to be accomplished under the DOT/PF Juneau Barrier-Free Access Project, the Mendenhall safety lanes project, and the Juneau areawide street improvements projects, as described in the attached Appendix A.

2. That upon the execution of an agreement, the city and borough shall assume responsibility for the administration of the projects and the funds.

3. That the city and borough manager or the manager's designee shall be the coordinator for each project. Further, the manager is authorized to execute necessary agreements and to do all things necessary to comply with the lawful requirements of DOT/PF including, without limitation, the designation of a project coordinator and amendments to the agreements increasing the amount of the grants.

4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
