RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1420

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO ACCEPT A \$40,000 GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AQUATIC EDUCATION TRAILS AND IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau Comprehensive Plan and Ordinance Serial No. 85-76am designate certain parcels of city and borough land located along Jordan Creek, Switzer Creek, and Bay Creek as park land, and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game has offered to the city and borough a \$40,000 grant for the development of aquatic education trails on city and borough land located along portions of Jordan Creek (near Floyd Dryden School), Switzer Creek, and Bay Creek (near Auke Bay School), and

WHEREAS, the funds are intended to be used to develop easily accessible trails for Juneau area schools to use in aquatic education programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the manager is authorized to accept a grant of \$40,000 from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game for the purpose of aquatic education trail development on city and borough property along portions of the Jordan Creek, Switzer Creek, and Bay Creek. The manager is further authorized to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Alaska Department of Fish and Game to accomplish the purpose of the grant.

2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
