RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO SUBMIT TO THE STATE OF ALASKA AN APPLICATION FOR A FEDERAL GRANT FOR THE SITES, STRUCTURES, BUILDINGS, AND OBJECTS SURVEY OF THE TREADWELL MINING DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the National Park Service Historic Preservation Act of 1966, certain federal share matching grants for historic preservation projects are available to certified local governments, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has reviewed the application prepared by the department of community development for such a federal share matching grant for the sites, structures, buildings, and objects survey of the Treadwell Mining District, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly is fully cognizant of the obligations and responsibilities that will be incurred by the city and borough upon acceptance of such grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the Assembly hereby authorizes the manager to submit an application to the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, for a federal share matching grant for the sites, structures, buildings, and objects survey of the Treadwell Mining District.

2. That the department of community development is established as the agent for the city and borough for the administration of this project.

3. That if the city and borough is awarded the grant for the sites, structures, buildings, and objects survey of the Treadwell Mining District, the Assembly will introduce an ordinance providing matching funds for this project.

4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
