Proposed Manager's Report

Resolution 1555:

This resolution establishes the capital improvement project priorities for the city and borough for Fiscal Year 1993 to be funded through the budget process by the sales tax fund. If this resolution is adopted, the capital improvement projects listed in the resolution and described in the documents in your packet will become a part of the Fiscal Year 1993 Budget. This resolution also adopts the Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 1993 -1998, which will be printed in final form after the resolution is adopted. A draft of the CIP program was distributed to the Assembly on January 6, 1992.

The Assembly Public Works and Facilities Committee has worked extensively on the development of this project priority list. The committee reviewed the project list at its meetings on February 5 and 19 and made modifications in the priority listing which have been incorporated into this resolution. The committee recommended that the project priorities, as established in the resolution before you this evening, be approved by the Assembly.
