RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOMINATION OF THE ERNEST GRUENING CABIN LOCATED AT AMALGA HARBOR TO THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE BY THE ALASKA STATE OFFICE OF HISTORY AND ARCHAEOLOGY.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City and Borough of Juneau Comprehensive Plan to identify and protect historic and archeological resources, and

WHEREAS, Ernest Gruening, Territorial Governor of Alaska from 1939 to 1953, was one of the principal architects of Alaska statehood, and

WHEREAS, the Gruening Cabin located at Amalga Harbor is the only building in Juneau, other than the Governor's Mansion, connected with Ernest Gruening, and


WHEREAS, the Juneau Historic District Advisory Committee has reviewed and recommended approval of the nomination of the Ernest Gruening Cabin to the National Register of Historic Places;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the Assembly hereby approves the nomination of the Ernest Gruening Cabin to the National Register of Historic Places to be submitted to the National Park Service by the Alaska State Office of History and Archeology.

2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
