## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

## Serial No. 1583

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO TRANSFER THREE SURPLUS AIRPORT RUNWAY TOW-BEHIND BROOMS TO THE STATE OF THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, Section 53.50.220 of the city and borough code requires Assembly approval by resolution prior to a transfer to another governmental or quasi-governmental unit of any surplus city and borough supplies with an estimated value of greater than two hundred dollars, and

WHEREAS, the Juneau International Airport has purchased three new trucks with broom attachments and has determined that its three existing tow-behind brooms are surplus to its needs, and

WHEREAS, the tow-behind brooms were originally purchased through a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration has authorized the disposal through surplus of the tow-behind brooms, and

WHEREAS, the estimated maximum value of the three towbehind brooms is \$6,000 and, with repairs, two of the brooms would be usable, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is willing to accept the surplus tow-behind brooms from the city and borough, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities intends to use the tow-behind brooms to maintain runways at the airports in Wrangell and Gustavus, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the best interests of the public and other Southeast Alaska communities would be served by the transfer of these tow-behind brooms to the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

- 1. That the manager is authorized to transfer three surplus airport runway tow-behind brooms (a 1964 Sicard, a 1975 SMI, and a 1982 SMI) to the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.
- 2. That the city and borough shall not be responsible for any costs or expenses associated with the transfer of the three tow-behind brooms to the State of Alaska, including but not limited to any costs or expenses associated with repairing, reconditioning, or shipping these brooms.
- 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
