
## Please Come and Learn About proposed new residential zoning for Downtown Juneau

TO:

Residential areas in the downtown Alternative Design Overlay District (ADOD) are proposed to be rezoned to create zoning regulations that better fit existing development patterns. The ADOD was adopted in 2017 as a temporary measure to provide relief for owners of properties considered "non-conforming" due to development that predates current zoning. The Community Development Department has drafted new residential zoning districts for the ADOD, which sunsets in August 2019, and invites the community to learn about what is proposed and offer feedback.
