RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AMENDMENTS 1 AND 2
TO THE MASTER PLAN FOR THE JUNEAU INTERNATIONAL
AIRPORT AND AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 574.

WHEREAS, in March of 1979 the assembly, by adoption of Resolution Serial No. 574, adopted a master plan for the Juneau International Airport, and

WHEREAS, certain facets of the plan have been reviewed in more detail and amendments have been recommended, and

WHEREAS, the planning commission has reviewed said amendments and provided its comments to the assembly,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the master plan developed by TRA Airport Consultants et al, adopted under Resolution 574 as the master plan for the future development of the Juneau International Airport is amended by substituting a new figure 4.2, the Land Use Plan of the Master Plan, dated November, 1982, a copy of which is attached hereto as attachment "A".

2. That said master plan is further amended by the adoption of amendment No. 2 dealing with helicopter operations and facilities, dated February, 1982; provided, in amendment No. 2, on page 24, a new subparagraph 6 is added reading:

6. Prior to the lease or development of property in the designated heliport area, general building and structure design criteria or a general site layout shall be developed for review and concurrence by the Planning Commission. Development in the area shall comply with the criteria or layout approved by the commission. Commercial use in the area must be strictly airport related.
